# **Covid Test Negative**

- Self isolate and return to work only when symptoms have resolved <a href="http://www.bccdc.ca/Health-Info-Site/Documents/Self-isolation.pdf">http://www.bccdc.ca/Health-Info-Site/Documents/Self-isolation.pdf</a>
- People who are **contacts of a confirmed case**, meaning they have been or could have been exposed to the virus but do not have symptoms, are required to *self-isolate* for at least 14 days
- Quarantine/self isolation is required ONLY for persons/workers entering BC from outside Canada self monitoring only (self isolation is not required) for those workers coming from across Canada
